	Maximum Overall Width – 2 ¾"						
	Minimum Width Between Wheels – 1 3/4" 1 and 3/4* 2 and 3/4*						
	Length – Truck with trailer, minimum of 13" long and a maximum of 17" long.						
	Height – One part of the truck or trailer must have a part running side to side, that has a minimum height of 3 1/2", but no taller than 4".						
	Minimum Track Clearance - Bottom clearance between car and track - 3/8"						
	Wheels and Axles – Truck and trailer must have ten wheels. They must be BSA. Wheels can not be reshaped and only dry lube is to be used. No bearings, washers or bushings allowed. Axles to be installed in the groves of the wooden blocks only.						
	Minimum Track Clearance 3/8* Height -3 and 1/2* minimum 4* maximum						
	Front of Truck – Front of truck must be flat side to side as to not extend beyond the starting post.						
	Details – Any detail parts can be used to accessorize your truck, however they must remain within the set width, length and height measurements.						
	Free Wheeling – The car must be free wheeling, with no starting devices.						
	Wheel Contact - All ten wheels MUST be in contact with a flat surface when the truck is placed on it.						
	Truck Construction – Truck shall consist of two parts. The truck and the trailer should be connected to allow side to side movement. No loose parts.						
	Maximum Weight – As raced, truck with trailer, not over 1 lb and 5 Ounces
